This makes this John W. Strange the same age as John W. the son of John W. and Rebecca of Jefferson County Tenn. so I believe that they are one and the same.

I believe that John W. and Rebecca (Unknown maiden name) Strange had a daughter named Zilphia born about 1826 in Tenn., married 29 Nov. 1846 in Jefferson County, Tenn. to Jesse Garner born about 1828 in NC, and I am told that Sarah E. Garner Strange had a brother named Jesse, so I wonder if John W. Strange did not marry a sister of Jesse Garner.

I believe that James, and John W. Strange Sr. were brothers. When I was in Jefferson County, TN in 1986 I talked to a Mrs. Helen Strange Cotton who had been researching the James Strange family, and she thinks they were brothers also, but we have not been able to prove this yet. One of the problems is that all the records in the Cocke, TN were destroyed before 1870, so there are no Court records there to check for marriages, etc., and that is where John M. Strange lived in the 1830 census, and probably his children were married there.

"John W. and Sarah E. Strange arrived in MO between Dec. 1856 and Jan. 1858, for in the 1860 census of Moniteau County MO shows John W. Strange, 28, his wife Sarah E. 27, Francis M. 4 all born in TN, and William H. 2 born in MO. They were living on a farm near the junction of 87 and 179 highways near Jamestown, Moniteau, MO. I have not been able to find where there was a deed recorded to John W. Strange in Moniteau County MO, so I do not know whether they owned this farm or not. They were still living in Moniteau County, MO in 1870 but were living in Miller County MO in 1880, where all the children grew up and all of them married except Daniel Fletcher.

I believe that they came to Missouri in a covered wagon pulled by a yoke of oxen, for in March 1859 John W. borrowed \$50 from a Mark Renfrow giving a yoke of oxen for security, and I have been told that Francis Marion (Gaylord's grandfather) was born in a covered wagon while on the road to MO."

Mrs. Sarah E. Strange was born in TN, in 1831, and departed this life at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Manda Wilson, at Jefferson City, Dec 19, 1929. She was married to John W. Strange in 1848. To this union 10 children were born, Marion, Russellville, MO; William and Jess and Henry, of Eldon; Daniel, of Shirley, MO; Mrs. Sallie Aber, of Baxter Springs, KS; Mrs. Manda Wilson, of Jefferson City, MO; and two sons and one daughter preceded her in death. Robert died in infancy; John M. died in 1926, and Mrs. Laura Blankenship in 1918.

She lived a devoted Christian life for a number of years. Grandma Strange as she was called among the young and old, was a kind and loving mother and a splendid neighbor. She was always ready and willing to help those in sickness and distress.

The day was never too cold or the night too dark and stormy for her to go to those who needed her, as long as her health would permit. She leaves seven children, 75 grandchildren, 150 great-grandchildren and 25

great-great grandchildren and a host of friends to mourn her passing.

The funeral services were conducted at the home of her granddaughter, Mrs. Lee Jobe, in Eldon, MO, by Rev. Wood, and body laid to rest in Dooley Cemetery.

45 Years Ago--July 26, 1923

Mrs. Sarah E. Strange, living near Eldon, MO, can boast of 217 living descendants, a record hard to equal in the state. She was born in TN in 1833, being more than 90 years of age. She enjoys remarkably good health, being able to do her own sewing and cooking. She can thread a needle or read without the aid of glasses.

She was married in 1849 and is the mother of 10 children, 9 of whom are living. The youngest living child is 41 years of age and the oldest 66. There are 106 grandchildren, 93 great-grandchildren, and 9 great-great grandchildren, making a total of 217 living descendants.

Mrs. Strange moved to Missouri in 1865 (note: she appears in the 1860 census in Moniteau County MO), and in 1875 settled in Miller County, where she has resided since.

Notes for MINNIE B. STRANGE:

Minnie B. Strange, husband Carney Parson and their three sons were all killed by a man named Jodie Hamilton. From information found in the TX County Library, the Parsons and Jodie Hamilton were apparently sharecropping on a Cantrell farm together. Carney decided to return to MO and had sold their part of the crop, plus a saddle, a single barrel shotgun, etc. for \$28. Jodie apparently decided this would be a good time to get his money back plus a wagon and team. When the murder was discovered, he accused another man and a lynch mob strung him up. He was cut down before any real damage was done. When he saw his well laid plans crumbling, he decided to flee and his big mistake was trying to flee on one of the Parsons mules. He was convicted and hanged for these murders.

Farmer Dies of Shotgun Blast

Death of L.E. Strange, 64, is at Home East of City--Leaves Note

Lewis Edgar Strange, 64, died at 10.15 o'clock last night at his farm home, six miles east of Chillicothe on US Highway 36. Death was from a shotgun wound in the face.

Funeral services will be conducted at 10 o'clock tomorrow (Tuesday) morning from the chapel of the Gordon Home for Funerals, conducted by the Rev. Norman Arbo of Meadville. The body will be taken to the Phillips Funeral home at Eldon, MO and funeral services will be held at 2 o'clock Wednesday afternoon at the Baptist church in Bagnell, MO. Burial will be in the Riley Lamm cemetery at Bagnell.

No inquest is planned. Dr. Joseph Conrado, Livingston County coroner, said death obviously was self-inflicted. Mr. Strange was found beside a small barn with the shotgun. There was a note in a pocket which said, in part, "Don't blame anybody." He had suffered from asthma 10 years, but apparently had been feeling better and had purchased a tractor to help with farm work. Members of the family had visited at the home during the day.

Mr. Strange was born Dec. 5, 1891, at Bagnell. He was a member of the Bagnell Baptist church, having united with the church when he was a young man. Sept. 25, 1912, he married Anna L. Conner at Bagnell. The family came to Livingston County in 1935 and established the home at its present location.
