Waltham Abbey *An analysis of the "Waltham's" is needed here and great care is needed when recording especially to distinguish the difference between the first two and the third:*

Waltham Holy Cross - Urban District, market town and parish 1 mile east of railway station called "Waltham Cross & Waltham Abbey" that is situated in Waltham Cross - it is the name of the ancient abbey that is within Waltham Abbey. The Urban District and parish are known as Waltham Abbey.

Waltham Abbey - Ecclesiastical District, when examining census records this place name must be considered to be synonymous with Waltham Holy Cross

Waltham Cross - Ecclesiastical District, village and now a railway station called "Waltham Cross & Waltham Abbey" serving Waltham Abbey 1 mile to the east - it is actually in Hertfordshire situated 1 mile south of Cheshunt.

who took a wife Rosetta CANNON. Both James and William apparently died in Canada.
So did James and Julia divorce or was her second marriage in bigamy
